

This is what we believe the SBA might ask for when applying:

- 1. 2019 IRS Quarterly 940, 941 or 944 payroll tax reports
- 2. Last 12 months of Payroll Reports beginning with your <u>last payroll date</u> and going backwards 12 months
 - a. Payroll report must show the following for the time period above:
 - Gross wages for each employee, including the officer(s) if paid
 W-2 wages
 - ii. Paid time off for each employee
 - iii. Vacation pay for each employee
 - iv. Family medical leave pay for each employee
 - v. State and Local taxes assessed on the employees' compensation for each employee
- 3. 1099's for 2019 for independent contractors that would otherwise be an employee of your business.
 - a. Do NOT include 1099's for services.
- 4. Documentation showing total of all health insurance premiums paid by the Company Owner under a group health plan.
 - a. Include all employees and the company owners
- 5. Document the sum of all retirement plan funding that was paid by the Company Owner (do not include funding that came from the employees' out of their paycheck deferrals).
 - a. Include all employees, including company owners
 - b. 401K plans, Simple IRA, SEP IRA's
